

Studio AMWA is making an open call from **January 7 through March 4** for applications to the AMWA Artist-in-Residence Program.

The **Artist in Residence Award** was started in 2015 by Studio AMWA to promote women members in the arts. The role of the artist in residence is to create an art project that is pertinent to AMWA and women in medicine. This art is to be displayed (or performed) during the following year's annual meeting.

This application is open to physician member artists, including painters, visual artists, sculptors, filmmakers, dancers, designers, puppeteers, or tailors. Other art forms considered at the discretion of the committee.

Please submit the following by midnight EST March 4 to k@gyrus.cc (AIR subcommittee lead and Doctor-Artist Mentor) and a copy to studioamwa@amwa-doc.org.

- Letter of Intent
- Resume (pdf) *
- Artist statement (400-word limit – pdf)*
- 4-5 images, video of your art, or your webpage*

Letter of Intent – Prepare one detailed page description of your plans for the residency. Please be sure to talk about how you and your work would benefit AMWA and women in medicine. Describe your prior art experience.

Artist Statement – tell us about you and your work (no more than 400 words)

Resume/CV – provide a simple and up-to-date resume or CV.

Additional Documents (optional) – feel free to provide relevant press or publications.

Media – Submit 4-5 images saved at 72dpi, and sized to 1200 pixels on the longest dimension. Files should not be larger than 5mb. Title your files: FirstLast_01.jpg (ex. JohnSmith_01.jpg). In the case of video work, please send a link to media from YouTube and Vimeo. Please also attach a document with a description of the work highlighted in each image.

**Note* - a link to a webpage with your artist statement, resume, and presentation of your work is a suitable alternative to separate documents.

The “Artist in Residence” Awardee agrees to:

1. Travel to the AMWA national meetings to receive the award and the following year to present the art project to the AMWA audience.
2. Promote AMWA and the arts at meetings or articles throughout the AIR year.
3. Work closely with Doctor-Artist Mentor during residency year and provide updates for feedback.
4. Receive 1/2 of the stipend at the award ceremony and the remainder upon completion of the project.
