This year's projects in Clinic Nepal:

- we served 4,455 patients at the clinic, laboratory and outreach clinics.
- Extensions of the south part of the existing building, resulting in 32.11 ft. x 14.4 ft. completed size, providing additional patient facilities and privacy space with an emergency exit.
- Supported building the new Birthing Centre and Clinic at Kailash Rural Municipality-8, Bharta of Makawanpur providing basic maternity and general health services, leading to a reduction in the mortality rates of mothers and babies.
- Clinic Nepal stand to provide Covid-19 safety awareness, Medical supplies and food ration relief in need, also reaching more than 300 families and 100 health institutions and non-profit organizations of various parts of Chitwan districts including rural villages.
- Three kindergartens are opening following the COVID-19 safety guidelines and 200 children from the age of 2-6 years benefit from the help.
- Throughout the year more than 153 girl and boy students have been sponsored for different schools and colleges in Nepal and studying Medicine and engineering in Germany.
- Friendship Scout Troop celebrated its 16th Anniversary on its premises in Wolfgang Linke Kindergarten, Bharatpur-27, Chitwan Scouts receive their certificate of appreciation in recognition of their valuable contribution and great team spirit in scouts.
- Handed over furniture to Shree Janaki secondary school Meghauli for the students of Class 11 and 12 grade 4 room. 10+2 Science and vocational project is running well with 34 students graduating by the end of 2021.
- Market place at Chitrawan Bharatpur -20 is doing better after it began with 32 stalls and now hosts 122 Stalls and attracts more than 1500 visitors per day.
- Also, the water project in Meghauli is doing fantastic in sustainable environment with the installation of 100kW solar energy tied with National Grid.
