**Satty Gill Keswani, MD to be Recognized with 2023 Esther Pohl Lovejoy Award  
at the American Medical Women's Association 2023 Annual Meeting**

**(Schaumburg IL)—March 8, 2023—** The American Medical Women's Association (AMWA) is delighted to announce that Satty Gill Keswani, MD, who has represented MWIA and now represents AMWA as NGO representative to the United Nations is the 2023 Esther Pohl Lovejoy Awardee. She will be presented with her award during the 108th AMWA Annual Meeting, March 23-26 in Philadelphia.

The Esther Pohl Lovejoy Award honors Dr. Lovejoy's work and legacy as a global humanitarian leader. She was a past president of AMWA, the first president of the Medical Women's International Association, and long-time Director of the American Women's Hospitals Service, AMWA's charitable relief program. This award is given to a woman physician who has demonstrated interest and dedication to the promotion of international relations through improvement in international health.

Dr. Satty Keswani arrived in the USA from New Delhi, India, in the late 1950s to find that no surgical residencies were available and that women were not welcome in the field. Instead, she chose obstetrics and gynecology as a specialty and after delivering over 1000 babies became intrigued by the problem of women who were unable to conceive. By 1967, she had found her life's work and had established a practice specializing in treating infertility. In private practice in Livingston, NJ for over 55 years, Dr. Keswani has successfully treated hundreds of couples for infertility while developing new methods to treat the problem.

A strong advocate for women in medicine, Dr. Keswani has served as a non-governmental organization delegate to the United Nations previously she represented MWIA and currently represents AMWA as NGO representative to the United Nations. She has been the recipient of several national and international awards.
